epSOS News: Open source reference implementation of NCP available

January, 25th 2013

To facilitate the realization of a National Contact Point (NCP), epSOS has created a second reference implementation of the technical infrastructure that connects the national eHealth system of a Participating Nation to the epSOS network. These common building blocks are usually referred to as the epSOS Common Software Components.

The first reference implementation (called NCP-in-a-Box), which has successfully been used by many participating nations, contains some proprietary software. The new reference implementation, commonly referred to as **OpenNCP 1.1.0**, is available under the open source GPLv3 and Apache Software License v2.
